Physical Development

We will be learning how to hold a pencil or pen with a comfortable grip. We will continue to use mark making tools to write our names, make books and create pictures.

When we are playing in the early years garden we will be playing group games such as duck, duck goose.



Understanding the World

We will use our senses to explore. We will touch and talk about the texture of different materials and use some of these to create a Bear Hunt story map. We will talk about different kinds of houses and find out what they are called. We will look at the houses that are around us at nursery. We will use our nursery camera to take photographs of our teddy bears.

Communication and Language

We will be developing our descriptive vocabulary as we read the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'. We will develop our conversation skills by taking turns to speak and listening to what others are saying.
