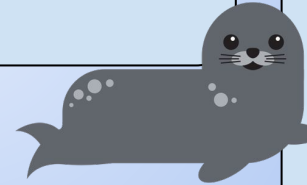
Communication and Language

We will be matching rhyming words and play some rhyming games.

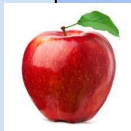


Personal, Social and Emotional
