Science - We will be looking at animals, including humans and categorising animals in different ways. We will explore carnivore, herbivore and omnivore and look at the various groups of animals, including birds, reptiles, mammals, fish and amphibians.

Maths: Power Maths scheme:

Year 1 - Spring 1

Children will be looking at addition and subtraction of numbers within 20. We will explore counting on from a number to solve addition problems and then use our knowledge of adding ones to help us solve problems up to 20 - then 50. At home, to support this, it would be beneficial to secure the understanding of number bonds to, and within, 10. Please ask if you would like more information about how to support this.

Reading:

The children will continue to learn to read through daily RWi phonics lessons. All children will come home with a RWi 'Book Bag' book that is matched to the sounds they are learning in school. Please can these be read daily with the children.

Children can also access the 'RWi E-Book **Library'** to access the texts and guizzes they are learning in school and at home. Loa in at Oxford Owl using details which can be found in their home school books.
