
Year 2 Autumn 2 2023

Science -

We will be Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other.

We will also be able to describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food

In this enquiry children learn about the continent of Antarctica and are able to locate it in relation to all the continents and oceans of the world and compare it to their local area. Through the study of hot and cold areas of the world pupils are able to understand why Antarctica is so cold and dry. The concept of a desert is developed through a comparative study of the Sahara Desert and pupils are able to consolidate their understanding of adaptation by comparing the life of Emperor Penguins

PSHE - This half term our 'health and Wellbeing' unit will be teaching the children how to keep themselves healthy.

Spellings: We will be giving the children 5 words each week to learn linked to a phonics sound. Their spelling dictation test will be each Thursday.

Maths - We will be using the Power Maths scheme of work to teach the children about addition and subtraction, across two units.
