
Year 3 - Spring 1

Science:

The children will be exploring forces and magnets. During this topic they will explore how forces can make objects start to move, speed up, slow down or change direction. They will compare how things move on different surfaces. They will carry out comparative and fair tests and go on to explain their findings in different ways. The children will classify

magnetic and nonmagnetic materials as well as exploring friction.



SCIENCE

Art: The children will be observing objects around them to sketch and then develop their shading skills. They will use different media to explore texture and then use this knowledge to create their own botanical drawings.

Maths: The children will continue to explore multiplication and division through the use of arrays and times tables. We will be focusing on the 3, 4 and 8 times tables and the related division facts. 
Music: Using the story of Chinese New Year as a stimulus, we will revise key musical terminology, play and create pentatonic melodies, compose a piece of music in a group and finally perform their finished pieces.

Writina:

We will be writing a page of instructions for an Information book. We will base this around the text 'Outdoor Wonderland'

In reading, most of the children will be using the text 'The Egyptian Cinderella' to enhance our fluency and inference skills. Some children will continue to access RWI and comprehension groups. Read Write Inc. will also continue.





RE: The children will be finding out about how and why people mark the significant events in their lives.



History: What is the secret of the standing stones?

This half term we will be learning about the Bronze Age. The children will find out why the Stone Age came to an end and how bronze was created by smelting copper and tin. We will find out about Merryvale and the significance of monuments. The children will research why the Amesbury Archer was so important in
