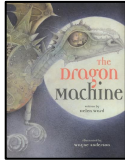
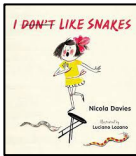


Year 2 Summer 2 2024

English - Our first story 'The Dragon Machine' we will be writing stories which have a problem and a solution.



Our second text we will be exploring a non-fiction text called 'I (don't) like snakes'.



Maths - We will be using the Power Maths scheme of work to teach the children about time, data and measure.

PSHE - Throughout this half-term, the Year 2 cohort will be undertaking PSHE lessons in transition. This will be centred around moving on, new things, changes etc. Whilst these are part of the PSHE curriculum, we hope it will also support our children with their move to Year 3.

Spellings: We will be giving the children 8 words each week from their Year 2 Common Exception Words list.. Their spelling dictation test will be each Thursday.

Science - The children will learn about the basic needs of humans for survival (food, water, air), the need for warmth and shelter. Children will identify simple differences between living and non-living things and they will then learn about the human life cycle.



Geography - The children will identify and describe the location of where they live in the UK, within Europe and the world and in relation to the Equator and north and south poles. They will compare their own location with the location of Kampong Ayer. They will identify, describe and observe the types of traditional homes found in Kampong Ayer and compare and contrast these with their own homes and types of homes found in the locality of their school. They will identify and describe the main elements which make up the weather and understand that weather conditions change from one moment to the next. They will recognise, describe and suggest reasons for the similarities and differences between school in Kampong Ayer and their own school.



Design Technology - The children will be explore levers, linkages and pivots through existing products and experimentation, use this research to construct and assemble a moving monster.

LEVERS & LINKAGES

RE - What makes some places sacred to believers? In RE they will explore that there are special places where people go to worship and that there are different holy buildings and different objects can found inside them. They will also investigate the similarities and differences between places of worship.



Computing - This term children will be learning about algorithms and how those lines of code can make a machine (beetbot) function. The children will explore how adaptations to algorithms affect the outcome, how different algorithms can reach the same output, and how to debug issues within code.



PE -The children will have PE every Tuesday & Friday afternoon with a focus on rackets and balls and athletics.

Music - Whole class instrument lessons: ocarina
Orchestral instruments.



Read Write Inc- The children will continue to have daily RWi lessons in school. The children will take home an AR/colour banded book as well as RWi book bag book to support their reading from home.
