Geography:

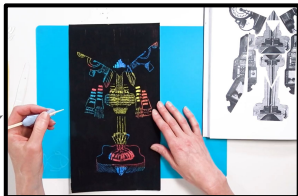
This half-term we will be learning about the Sunshine State of Florida.
