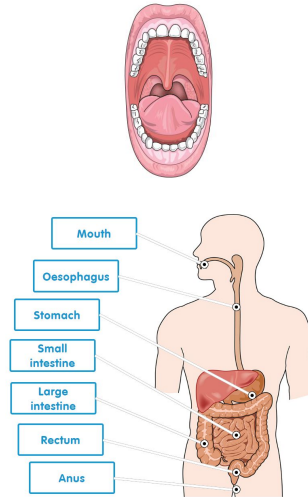


Year 4 - Autumn



Science : This half term in Year 4 we will be learning all about the digestive health of our bodies. The children will be learning to describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans. We will be identifying the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions. Then we will be making and interpreting a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey



Maths - We will be using the Power Maths scheme of work to teach the children about place value. Children will also be learning all of their timetables using a range of class learning and TT Rockstars. Please check [My Maths](#) weekly for online maths homework.



D&T: We will be looking at fastenings and a range of different fastening types. By the end of the unit the children will have produced and designed a book sleeve using stitches they are comfortable with.
